



## Beginner-Friendly Workshop Tool Checklist



### Cutting Tools

- Handsaw – basic, reliable, no power needed.
- Jigsaw – perfect for curves & irregular cuts.
- Circular Saw – fast straight cuts
- Utility Knife – cutting soft materials, scoring, marking lines.



### Measuring & Marking Tools

- Tape Measure (5–8 m / 16–25 ft)
- Combination / Carpenter Square – keeps cuts 90°.
- Spirit Level – essential for perfectly straight builds.
- Marking Pencil / Carpenter's Pencil
- Chalk Line – for marking straight lines.



### Drilling & Fastening Tools

- Cordless Drill – the #1 must-have tool in any workshop.
- Drill Bit Set (wood + metal)
- Screwdriver Set – always useful.
- Impact Driver (optional) – more power for long screws.
- Wood Screws Assortment
- Wood Glue – strong joints, beginner-friendly.



### Shaping & Smoothing Tools

- Sanding Block
- Assorted Sandpaper (80 / 120 / 240 grit)
- Orbital Sander (optional) – saves time on larger surfaces.
- Wood Chisel Set – useful for cleaning joints and fine work.



### Holding & Supporting Tools

- Clamps (various sizes) – you can never have enough.
- Workbench or Work Table
- Sawhorses (1–2 pairs) – essential during wall or roof assembly.



### Safety Gear

- Safety Glasses
- Ear Protection
- Dust Mask / Respirator
- Work Gloves
- First Aid Kit – always have one nearby.
